RULES FOR REVALUATION OF SCRIPTS

1. The application with prescribed fee for revaluation of answer script should be submitted untp 20 days from the date of issue of Memorandum of Marks.
2. The answer book will be revalued independently by an examiner chosen from outside the University area.
3. If the difference is less than 10% of maximum marks between the original marks and the marks given by the examiners valuing the paper, the original marks will stand good.
4. If the difference is 10% but not more than 20% between the original marks and the marks given by the examiner who revalued the answer paper, the marks given on revaluation will be taken as the marks of the candidate.
5. If the difference exceeds more than 20% even on second revaluation, the average of the two revaluation marks shall be awarded to the candidate.
